

RULES FOR GREAT LAKES SECTION IFT SUPPLIERS NIGHT EXHIBITS

- I. The Great Lakes Section IFT will provide a 10' x 10' piped and draped booth area with a standard six or eight-foot skirted and draped table, two chairs, wastebasket and a standard booth sign.
- II. The exhibit consists of all booths arranged side-by-side in rows with suitable aisles between the rows as needed for traffic flow.
- III. Permitted at table top displays:
 1. Educational & sales literature
 2. Samples of ingredients, additives, or food products
 3. Sales premiums, souvenirs, handouts, etc.
 4. Instruments and/or equipment
- IV. Prohibited at table top displays:
 1. Large free-standing floor displays (exceptions possible)
 2. Activities or loud noises that disturb other exhibitors
 3. Solicitation, interviews, distribution of literature, etc. outside the confines of the exhibitor's booth or booth area
- V. Only Section provided exhibitor standard identification signs are allowed (hanging); Table cover signage permitted
- VI. Exhibit booths or free-standing displays are limited to those which can be carried in, set up, torn down, and carried out by the exhibiting personnel.
- VII. By completion of the Suppliers' Night space allocation form, the exhibitor agrees to conform to the rules of the exhibition.

The IFT, Great Lakes Sections and its agents and employees assume no risk, and by the acceptance of this agreement the exhibitor expressly releases them of and from any and all liability for damage, injury or loss to any person or goods, from any cause whatsoever.
