2011 STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION*

Undergraduate Achievement Award - \$1000 Award

Eligibility: Recipient shall be an undergraduate student who is enrolled full time in food science, nutrition, food engineering, food packaging, food service or other related curriculum leading to a bachelor degree.

Clifford L Bedford Scholarship - \$1000 Award

Eligibility: Recipient shall be an undergraduate student who is a declared food science, nutrition, food engineering, food packaging or food service curriculum leading to a bachelor degree and intends to pursue a career in the food industry.

Master of Science Achievement Scholarship – \$1000 Awards

Eligibility: Recipient shall be a Master's of Science candidate in Food Science in good academic standing.

Ph.D Achievement Scholarship – \$1000 Awards

Eligibility: Recipient shall be a Ph.D candidate in Food Science in good academic standing.

Great Lakes Section Diversity Scholarship - \$1000 Award

Eligibility: Recipient must be a full-time minority student (either graduate or undergraduate) with a declared curriculum of food science, nutrition, food packaging, food engineering or other related disciplines with plans to pursue a career in the food industry.

Great Lakes Section Active Student Member Scholarship - \$1000 Award

Eligibility: Recipient must be a full time student (either graduate or undergraduate) with a declared curriculum of food science, nutrition, food packaging, food engineering or other related disciplines with plans to pursue a career in the food industry and show active involvement in the Great Lakes Section of IFT as well as other activities of IFT.

**In the event of a tie for any of the awards, the award will be split equally between the tied applicants, but will not be less than \$500 per awardee.*

DEADLINE FOR SUBMISSION IS FEBRUARY 1, 2011

Basic Requirements For All Awards:

- 1) At least a 3.0 GPA
- 2) Membership in IFT and GLS-IFT (\$5)
- 3) Enrolled in an accredited Michigan college or university

Selection of all award recipients will be made by the Scholarship Awards Committee as outlined by the GLS-IFT by-laws.

 - a. The completed application form.
 - b. A **ONE PAGE** personal statement, which includes a summary of:
 - 1) Academic program and GPA
 - 2) Current research (if applicable)
 - 3) Future plans and career goals
 - 4) Extracurricular activities which may include involvement in community, university/college activities, GLS activities or national IFT activities
 - 6) Work experience
 - c. **Two signed letters of recommendation with your name and GL-IFT on the sealed envelopes.** Letters must be from faculty members or employers familiar with his/her training and other abilities.
3. Applications which do not conform to these guidelines will be returned without consideration.
